- Successful completion of a two-year postdoctoral residency in clinical neuropsychology
- Active license as a psychologist or eligibility for licensure as a psychologist in California
- ABPP board certification in clinical neuropsychology or eligibility to pursue ABPP board certification in clinical neuropsychology AND motivation to pursue ABPP board certification
